ARTS COUNCIL FOR LONG BEACH IS SEEKING A VISUAL ARTIST TO SERVE ON THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR PUBLIC ART (ACPA)

LONG BEACH – The Arts Council for Long Beach seeks a visual artist to serve as a member of its Advisory Committee for Public Art (ACPA). The ACPA reviews development plans for conformance with the city’s percent-for-art program, which is tied to redevelopment projects exceeding \$10 million in total cost. In addition, ACPA appoints committees for specific projects and reviews on-site public art programs. It is a recommendation body to the Public Art Program of the Arts Council for Long Beach.

ACPA is comprised of volunteer representatives from the community-at-large, artists, Redevelopment Agency staff and arts-related professionals. The committee meets at 9:30 AM on the third Tuesday of each month.

Local visual artists who live or work in Long Beach are encouraged to apply for ACPA membership. No member of ACPA or his/her immediate family is eligible to apply for public art projects in the City of Long Beach. Art dealers and private for-profit arts consultants are ineligible for ACPA membership.
